

Cold Porcelain

MATERIAL NEEDED:

- * 1 cup (240ml) Cornflour
- * 1 cup (240ml) PVA glue
- * 2 tablespoon of vinegar
- * 2 tablespoon of cooking oil



Cold porcelain clay is an interesting material: simple to make at home, gives great results. It's malleable and easy to mould, but it becomes hard and plastic-like once it dries.

Put all the wet ingredients in a microwavable bowl. Add the cornflour and mix till a goeey texture.

Pop it in the microwave for fifteen seconds and repeat this process for three times.

Between these intervals take it out and mix it with either a spoon or a kebab stick.

You will start to see the top turning into a matt finish and the clay getting hard.



Knead the dough on a no-sticky mat (or a sheet of baking paper). **BE CARFEUL!** The clay is very **HOT!** Let it cool down. Then wrap it up ad store in the fridge.

Use it to create what you want and let it dry hard. Depending on the size and shape of your creation, this might take from a few hours to several days.



Once the your object is dry you can paint and decorate it with acrylics or craft paint.
